## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

IrrigAid Gold may be applied through any type of irrigation system. It will not burn foliage. Ideal for use in vineyards, tree crops, row crops, potatoes, tomatoes and as a general purpose soil surfactant in amenities and gardens.

Situation	Rate	Critical comments
Injection through irrigation systems	2.5 – 10 Litres / ha	Inject IrrigAid Gold through any type of irrigation system (except earthen ditches)
Conventional sprayers	2.5 – 10 Litres / ha	Irrigation or rainfall should follow application.
Transplant purposes	700 ml - 2.5 L per 1000L of transplant water	Apply with first watering after transplanting.
Garden and amenities	10 to 20 Litres / ha	Apply through boom spray or with irrigation water.

## PROTECTION OF WILDLIFE, FISH, CRUSTACEANS AND ENVIRONMENT

DO NOT contaminate streams, rivers or waterways with the chemical or used containers.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in the closed, original container in a dry, cool, well-ventilated area out of direct sunlight. Triple or preferably pressure rinse containers before disposal. Add rinsings to soaking solution. DO NOT dispose of undiluted chemicals on site. Dispose of the unwanted cleaning material in a marked disposal pit. If recycling, replace cap and return clean containers to recycler to designated collection point.

If not recycling, break, crush or puncture and bury empty containers in a local authority landfill. If no landfill is available bury containers below 500 mm in a disposal pit specifically set up for this purpose clear of waterways, desirable vegetation and tree roots. Empty containers and product should not be burnt.
